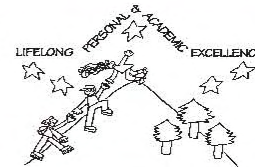

BACK TO SCHOOL IN PINEDALE

First Day for Teachers: Monday, August 28
 First Day for Students: Tuesday, September 5

IMMUNIZATIONS: SEA 3-SF28 Immunization Amends W.S. 21-4-309, mandatory immunizations for children attending schools. The age requirement for the required immunizations has been increased from 10 years old to Kindergarten through twelfth grade. The act now states, "any person entering initially or transferring from another school into Kindergarten through twelfth grade of any public or private school shall provide a record of immunization within 30 days..." The administrator of the school shall be responsible for an audit of the immunization status of any child enrolled in the school accord with the rules and regulations prescribed by the Department of Health and Social Services. The remaining portion of the new act is unchanged. Effective date: July 1, 1987.

Transportation or maintenance of isolated students: Those parents who qualify under the isolation policies may contact the Transportation Director of Sublette County School District No. 1 for an application. This filing must be done each year. The applications need to be filed no later than November 1 each year to qualify, unless eligibility begins after this date. In these cases, 60 days is given after such eligibility begins.

PINEDALE HIGH SCHOOL

All students report to their first period class at 8:15 a.m. on the first day of school, Tuesday Sept. 5, 2006. Students schedules and all other pertinent information will be mailed home prior to the first day of school. Any student who has not re-registered or pre-registered should do so at the high school office beginning Tuesday, August 15. There will be a special orientation day for new students, incoming freshmen, and their parents on Thursday, August 31. A get-acquainted meeting will be held in the high school library at 1:30 p.m. and a tour of the building will follow.

PINEDALE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

The 2006 - 2007 school year will begin Tuesday, September 5, 2006. All new elementary students grade 1 - 5 and Kindergarten should register at the elementary school office by Thursday, August 31. Children must be five years of age on or before September 15 to be admitted to Kindergarten and six years of age on or before September 15 for first grade. Please bring birth certificates and health immunization records. A physical examination is also required for Kindergarten students. Forms may be picked up at the school office.
